The (OS1) audit contains over 260 factors that have been benchmarked as best practices in cleaning organizations. The certification criteria demonstrate that a cleaning organization is using practices that cause a facility to be clean, with a minimal environmental impact.

Successful candidates must document to the outside auditor that they are actively reducing hazardous chemicals and waste, reusing cleaning materials rather than sending them to the landfill, cleaning safely and effectively recycling.

By attaining the (OS1) Green Certified Program designation, The Kings partnered with The Boeing Company to demonstrate their joint commitment to excellence. The award recognizes organizations work apply practical projects to minimize environmental harm. Successful candidates must document they have adopted a green process of cleaning management.

It was first installed in 1991 at the Delta Center in Salt Lake City, home of the Utah Jazz. (OS1) is based on principles of scientific cleaning management including cleaning for health first (then appearance), treating cleaning workers as first class citizens, simplification, standardization, tracking, continuous measuring and improving and low environmental impact cleaning activities.
